

Chapter 2

Basic Number or Character Number

The basic number is the number which decides the main character of the person. It is the single number which is obtained by adding the digits (if double digit) of the date of birth of the person. The numbers 1 to 9 are the basic numbers of the number system. Any number above 9 are obtained by adding its digits.

Example 1:

If a person is born on the 25th of September 1978 , then the basic number of this person is $2+5 = 7$.

Example 2:

If a person is born on the 3rd of July 1984 , then the basic number of this person is **3**.

Example 3:

If a person is born on the 13th of May 1980 , then the basic number of this person is $1+3 = 4$.

Similarly the basic numbers of the people can be obtained.

Now the character of the people born under the respective numbers can be explained.
